Until you go, you have no idea just how much there is to see and do – and how much you'll enjoy it. We'll enjoy the different regions of Britain including London, the beautiful Midlands, northern England plus Scotland and Wales. It is a lovely sampling of what Britain has to offer, and with excellent local guides that will bring it to life.

September 6/7: Depart USA

Today we meet at the airport to board our flight through the east coast to **London**. Dinner and breakfast are included on the flight. We arrive on the morning of September 7. Feel the vibrant energy of England, hear the unique sounds of Scotland and see the rolling countryside of Wales on a trip that combines the exploration of dramatic history and natural wonders. We'll begin to explore some of the places that make London famous before checking into our hotel. Tonight, we'll enjoy a **welcome dinner together**.

September 8: London

This morning, we see the quintessential sights of London hosted by a local guide. We'll see **Buckingham Palace, the Tower of London, Big Ben, the Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey**, and the changing of the guard (if held). London has one of the best live theatre scenes in the world. During some free time, you can spend some time at Harrods or in Hyde Park. There is lots to do and see in London. **Later today, you'll have an option to enjoy one of London's spectacular theatre performances.** *Today breakfast will be included.*

September 9: London - Oxford - Ruthin, Wales

Today we visit **Oxford**, home of the famous university which is more than 800 years old. We'll show you the highlights and give you some time to enjoy the town. The setting is lovely and the history here is rich. In the afternoon, we enjoy a scenic drive across central England into **Wales**. We end our day with an overnight stay in beautiful **Ruthin Castle** situated in the north of Wales. **Tonight, enjoy a typical Welsh-style dinner followed by traditional entertainment.** *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

September 10: Wales - Lake District, England - Edinburgh, Scotland

Today we continue through a portion of northern Wales arriving mid morning in the picturesque English **Lake District**. In the heart of the Lake District, we'll visit the charming village of **Grasmere**, home of the poet William Wordsworth. This is England as you picture it – a quaint village set on a lovely lake. We'll enjoy a little time here before continuing to **Scotland** where your first stop is at the border town of **Gretna Green**. This is where generations of runaway couples came to be married. Today's final destination is **Edinburgh**, the "Athens of the North." Edinburgh is an elegant city guarded by its imposing castle that sits majestically atop the city. Enjoy discovering Scotland's exciting capital city which is rich in scenic beauty and culture. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

September 11: Edinburgh

Enjoy a locally-guided tour of Edinburgh that includes a visit to **Edinburgh Castle**, home of the Scottish crown jewels. We will get a glimpse at what life is like for the royals during our visit to the **Palace of Holyroodhouse** (unless the queen is in the residence), **the Queen's official residence in Edinburgh** and once the home of Mary, Queen of Scots. It is one of the most interesting things to see in the city. Our evening is at leisure to sample one of Edinburgh's fine restaurants and perhaps take an evening stroll through Princes Street Gardens to view the illuminated castle above us. *Today breakfast will be included.*

September 12: Edinburgh - Border Region - York, England

Today we head south through Scotland's rolling Border region back to England, but on the eastern side. Stretching across the country is **Hadrian's Wall**, which once marked the northern border of the Roman Empire. Stop to see this ancient fortification that was begun in AD 122 to protect **Roman Britain** from the tribes of Scotland. Later, we'll continue on to the important city of **York**, where we'll stroll through this medieval city. We'll see the famous **Minster** and walk on the "Shambles," a quaint, narrow street that appears today almost as it did during the Middle Ages. Here you'll find great shopping and a street that is so narrow in parts that you can almost reach both sides with your outstretched arms. It is charming and a very interesting place to visit. We'll stay in the lovely Marriott Hotel in the heart of the city tonight. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

September 13: York - Stratford-upon-Avon

This morning our journey takes us through the rolling hills of central England making our way to one of the highlights of the trip: **Stratford-upon-Avon**, our home for the next two nights. This is the birthplace of **William Shakespeare**, England's most famous playwright. This is the intriguing Midlands of England with its carefully manicured towns, quaint thatched roofs and stunning English gardens. We'll walk in Shakespeare's footsteps, visiting his birthplace as well as **Anne Hathaway's thatch-roofed cottage**, the childhood home of the author's wife. Tonight, we'll drive to the nearby town of Warwick and enjoy a delicious dinner at the magnificent and historical 1,000-year-old **Warwick Castle**. This medieval castle is perched majestically on the Avon River and we'll enjoy a dinner to remember. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

September 14: Stratford-upon-Avon - Bath - Stonehenge - Stratford-upon-Avon

Travel through some of England's most beautiful **countryside**. Stop in the ancient Roman town of **Bath** - renowned for more than 2,000 years for its spas and natural hot springs. But that's only the beginning. The setting for the town is stunning set against the verdant, rolling hills with a stunning mix of old and new. It is one of the highlights in all of the British Isles. While here, we'll visit the **Roman Baths Museum** to see the elaborate spas, valued since Roman times for their curative properties. We'll also have some time for browsing in a setting that is unrivaled. You will love the town of Bath. Finally, no visit to Britain would be complete without a visit to the mysterious **Stonehenge**, standing alone in the English countryside. We'll hear some of the theories and guess at what it might have been. Tonight, we'll celebrate with a great trip by enjoying a farewell dinner. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

September 15: Stratford-upon-Avon to the Airport.

This morning after a nice breakfast, we'll board our coach and travel to the airport for our flights back to the USA. *Breakfast will be included.*

Registration Information:

To make a reservation, simply **fill out the attached reservation form and send it to us with a deposit of \$400 per person.** When we receive your deposit, we will mail you a receipt confirming that you are registered for the tour. A letter with instructions, hotel itinerary flight information (if applicable) and luggage tags will be sent 60 days prior to departure at which time the balance will be due. You do not need to pay the balance until after you receive that packet. We require final payments in the form of a check. If that is not possible, arrangements can be made to use a credit card. Webb Tours accepts Visa, Mastercard and Discover.

Cancellation Penalties

We understand that you may need to cancel your trip for whatever reason. If it is 75 days or more before departure, all money will be refunded. If it is within 75 days, we will charge you only what Webb Tours cannot recover. In some cases, we can recover all of it. In others, we cannot. Cruise lines, airlines, hotels and other service providers require funds in advance and have their own rules about what will be refunded once paid. We must follow their guidelines. For airlines, specifically, tickets are generally non refundable when purchased. However, most airlines will allow the value of the canceled tickets to be reused for future travel, though a penalty may be assessed to reuse the tickets. If you have to cancel, Webb Tours will work with other providers to obtain as much refund as possible for our travelers. Our travelers know us to be very fair in this regard.

Cancellation Insurance:

To avoid cancellation penalties, cancellation insurance may be purchased. This insurance will reimburse you for the non-refundable cancellation penalties imposed if you must cancel your trip for a covered reason such as illness, injury or death to you, a traveling companion or an immediate family member. Other reasons for cancellation include Common Carrier-caused delays due to inclement weather, jury duty, or a documented traffic accident en route to departure.

The per person price for insurance for this tour is \$195

This insurance covers the land portion of your tour. Airline tickets would be returned to you for future use (less any penalties charged by the airlines). If you are interested in the insurance, it is best to purchase it when your deposit is made as all preexisting conditions are waived. However, insurance may be purchased any time up to the point you make your final payment. Insurance cannot be purchased after your final payment is made. Webb Tours is not the insurer and acts as agent for the insurance company. To activate your insurance, we need your premium and your birth date. **Travel insurance also includes \$2,500 for baggage loss, \$500 for baggage delay, up to \$50,000 for medical expenses and up to \$50,000 for medical evacuation.**

Currency Fluctuation:

Webb Tours reserves the right to adjust the rates if necessary in order to reflect currency fluctuations larger than 10% from those used in our tour price. This is not likely to happen, but we must protect against it. A shift of that magnitude would quickly erase our tour profits. Of course, if the fluctuation moves in the opposite direction, we will reduce your tour price.
