With this cruise, we fly to NYC and enjoy an **optional show** before boarding the ship for a 7 day cruise. At each port, we offer private excursions for any who are interested in joining us*. A director will be with you to make sure you get the most out of your vacation. But this is time for peak foliage so to get the best stateroom, you should get on board early – REMEMBER, you can cancel anytime for any reason up to July 12th, so don't be left out!*

Daily Itinerary:

September 28, 2012: Today we board our flight to **New York City** arriving in the late afternoon. We stay in Mid-Town Manhattan. Chance to see an optional **Broadway** show this evening which we can arrange for you.

September 29: Today we'll show you several highlights of New York City including **Central Park, Ground Zero, Times Square** and other landmarks that make the Big Apple famous. By lunchtime, we arrive at the port and board the beautiful **Caribbean Princess**. We sail in the afternoon. Bon Voyage!

September 30: Today we will be at sea making our way to **Maritime Canada**. Enjoy the luxurious Caribbean Princess with multiple restaurants, theaters, pools, hot tubs, spa, boutiques and MUCH more.

October 1: Port of Call in **Halifax**. Our optional private excursion today will show you some of the sights of Halifax (Citadel, Public Gardens) before driving out to the UNESCO town of **Lunenburg**, on the south coast of Nova Scotia. It is about 90 minutes away and WELL worth the drive. This planned British settlement is known as the "fishing capital of the world". It is VERY charming.

October 2: This morning we dock in **St. John, New Brunswick**. Our optional excursion takes us an hour to the northeast to the charming town of **St. Martens**. The two covered bridges and tree covered hills make it a lovely fall scene. We'll have world famous clam chowder for lunch and a chance to see the **Sea Caves** formed by the tides. We are on the **Bay of Fundy**, with the largest daily tidal changes in the world. It is fascinating to see.

October 3: We spend the day in beautiful **Bar Harbor, Maine**. Our 3 hour excursion takes you into **Acadia National Park** with stops at Sandy Beach, Jordan's Pond, Cadillac Mountain and more. Fall scenes are spectacular. You then have plenty of time to enjoy the town of Bar Harbor at your leisure returning to the ship when you're ready.

October 4: Welcome to **Boston**. Those interested, can join us for a 3 hour tour of the historic sites in the city with an excellent local guide, followed by lunch in **Quincy Market**. We depart at 4:00 and continue our journey.

October 5: Port of Call in **Newport, Rhode Island**. Our optional private excursion takes you on the famous **12-mile drive** showcasing the mansions of Newport, with a tour inside of the Vanderbilt's **Breakers Mansion**.

October 6: This morning we sail into the New York Harbor (past the **Statue of Liberty**) and transfer to the airport.

Registration Information:

To make a reservation, simply **fill out the attached reservation form and send it to us with a deposit of \$300 per person.** When we receive your deposit, we will mail you a receipt confirming that you are registered for the tour. A letter with instructions, hotel address, flight information and more will be sent 90 days prior to departure at which time the balance will be due. You do not need to pay the balance until after you receive that packet. We require final payments in the form of a check. If that is not possible, arrangements can be made to use a credit card. Webb Tours accepts Visa, Mastercard and Discover for tour deposits.

Cancellation Penalties

We understand that you may need to cancel your trip for whatever reason. If it is 76 days or more before departure, all money will be refunded. If it is within 75 days, we will charge you only what the cruise line charges us. If cancellation occurs between 75 days and 31 days prior to departure, you will forfeit your deposit. If it is within 30 days of departure, additional penalties (up to the total amount) will apply. For airlines, specifically, tickets are generally non refundable when purchased. However, most airlines will allow the value of the canceled tickets to be reused for future travel, though a penalty may be assessed to reuse the tickets. If you have to cancel, Webb Tours will work with other providers to obtain as much refund as possible for our travelers. Our travelers know us to be very fair in this regard.

Cancellation Insurance:

Cancellation insurance is also available should you be interested. The insurance provider that we use is a company called Travelex. You can learn about them at www.travelexinsurance.com. With this insurance, most of your money will be returned to you in case you have to cancel for covered reasons (illness or death of an immediate family member) at the last minute. The price for the insurance varies based on the price of the trip and the age of the participant (at the time the insurance is purchased). Prices are as follows:

If you are interested in the insurance, it is best to purchase it when your deposit is made as all preexisting conditions are waived. However, insurance may be purchased any time up to the point you make your final payment. Insurance cannot be purchased after your final payment is made. Webb Tours is not the insurer and acts as agent for Travelex. To activate your insurance, we need your premium and your birth date. **Insurance also includes trip interruption coverage (if you have to leave the tour early), \$500,000 medical evacuation, \$50,000 in medical benefits, \$1,000 for lost baggage and \$250 for baggage delay.**
