This will be our 39th consecutive trip to see the Rose Parade in Southern California. We've learned a lot over the years and we think you'll like what we have in store. SO read on. This tour is popular every year. The tour is packed with unique activities but at a relaxed pace. You'll feel like you're getting your money's worth, but we won't run you ragged. After all, you're on vacation. We include excellent hotels and several delicious meals. When you see what you get for the price, you'll agree that it's a great value. So don't trust your Rose Parade experience to just anyone. Join us for Utah's most popular Rose Parade Tour!

December 30: We'll meet at the Salt Lake Airport for our flight to Los Angeles, arriving mid day. After lunch, we'll go directly to Pasadena where we'll visit one of the warehouses where the **floats are being assembled**. There is a flurry of activity as the live flowers are scattered over the floats. You can walk within 3 feet of about 1/3 of the parade floats and have a chance to really appreciate the detail that goes into every float. It's amazing to see. After checking into the hotel, we'll drive out to Hollywood where you can enjoy some time for dinner on the famous corner of Hollywood and Highland (lots of choices). See the **Kodak Theater, Walk of Fame, the Hollywood sign, Grauman's Chinese Theater** and more. Tonight you will have a chance to see the Broadway hit "**WICKED**" at the Pantages Theater just up the street. If you have seen Wicked before, or are not interested, the coach will take you back to the hotel. *Tour to pay for flight and float viewing.*

Note: Wicked Tickets are \$80 per person. If you are interested in seeing Wicked, please mark it on your reservation form. The price of the tickets will be added to your final invoice.

December 31: After a relaxing morning today, we'll enjoy a scenic drive to Escondido (about 90 minutes away) where a delicious lunch buffet awaits at the **Lawrence Welk Resort**. After lunch, we'll enjoy a holiday tradition called **An A Cappella Christmas**. This is a family show for all ages filled with comedy, and Christmas classics performed by the popular **Alley Cats** which are four incredible male voices. After the show, you'll have time for strolling or browsing on your own at lovely **Coronado Island** where you can wander the grounds of the famous "**Hotel Del Coronado**" with its impressive Christmas decorations. We'll then return to our Long Beach hotel. *Tour to pay for lunch and show.*

January 1: Today is New Year's Day and you have a choice. EITHER option is included in the tour price and you'll be able to choose the one that is most appealing to you:

Option 1: Catalina Island. This is a great day to go to the harbor and enjoy a relaxing boat ride to **Catalina Island**. We'll arrive there about 10:30. Upon arrival, you'll have the option to enjoy an **interesting tour of the island** which everyone loves (highly recommended). After lunch, you'll have time to browse in the waterfront town of **Avalon** or choose an additional activity on the island. We'll return via the Catalina Flyer at about 4:00 and enjoy a rest at the hotel before dinner.

Option 2: Variety of Unique Activities. Alternatively, you could spend your day enjoying **three** unique activities in the area. Five minutes from our hotel is the **Gondola Getaway**. We'll board our "Venice-style" gondolas as we enjoy a relaxing one hour ride through some exclusive residential areas on the water. Your gondolier will sing to you and share stories as you float through this waterways of Naples Islands. We'll then drive to Pasadena and visit the world famous **Gamble House** – an architectural masterpiece built over 100 years ago (for the owner of Proctor & Gamble), now a museum. Finally, we'll enjoy a stroll through the beautiful grounds of the **Huntington Library**. This is 120 landscaped acres in a beautiful setting. We'll return to the hotel at about 4:00 and rest before going to dinner.

Whether you choose option one or two, we'll all drive over to **Knotts Berry Farm** for their famous chicken dinner. We'll be back by 9:00 so you can rest up for an early and exciting day tomorrow. *Tour to pay for breakfast, dinner and boat ride to Catalina Island OR admission to Gondola Getaway/Gamble House/Huntington Library grounds.*

January 2: This morning we will arise early and head for Pasadena for the **123rd Annual Tournament of Roses Parade**. The parade continues to get better year after year. You'll be among the first to see the spectacle as our excellent reserved seats are at the beginning of the parade route (near the network television booths). We have an unobstructed view in both directions and the sun is at our backs. In addition, the bus parks right behind our seats which is very convenient. It is often chilly until the sun comes up so it's nice to have the bus close by just in case. It is the **BEST POSSIBLE scenario for Rose Parade seats** (we have enjoyed these seats for over 30 years). After the parade, we will enjoy a chance to see all of the floats up close at the post parade float viewing before transferring to the airport for our non stop flight back to Salt Lake. *Tour to pay for light breakfast, parade seats and float viewing.*

Registration Information:

To make a reservation, simply **fill out the attached reservation form and send it to us with a deposit of \$300 per person.** When we receive your deposit, we will mail you a receipt confirming that you are registered for the tour. A letter with instructions, hotel itinerary flight information (if applicable) and luggage tags will be sent 45-60 days prior to departure at which time the balance will be due. You do not need to pay the balance until after you receive that packet. We require final payments in the form of a check. If that is not possible, arrangements can be made to use a credit card. Webb Tours accepts Visa, Mastercard and Discover.

Cancellation Penalties

We understand that you may need to cancel your trip for whatever reason. If it is 60 days or more before departure, all money will be refunded. If it is within 60 days, we will charge you only what Webb Tours cannot recover. In some cases, we can recover all of it. In others, we cannot. Cruise lines, airlines, hotels and other service providers require funds in advance and have their own rules about what will be refunded once paid. We must follow their guidelines. For airlines, specifically, tickets are generally non refundable when purchased. However, most airlines will allow the value of the canceled tickets to be reused for future travel, though a penalty may be assessed to reuse the tickets. If you have to cancel, Webb Tours will work with other providers to obtain as much refund as possible for our travelers. Our travelers know us to be very fair in this regard.

Cancellation Insurance:

Cancellation insurance is also available should you be interested. The insurance provider that we use is a company called Travelex. You can learn about them at www.travelexinsurance.com. With this insurance, most of your money will be returned to you in case you have to cancel for covered reasons (illness or death of an immediate family member) at the last minute. The price for the insurance varies based on the price of the trip and the age of the participant (at the time the insurance is purchased). Prices are as follows:

However, insurance may be purchased any time up to the point you make your final payment. Insurance cannot be purchased after your final payment is made. Webb Tours is not the insurer and acts as agent for Travelex. To activate your insurance, we need your premium and your birth date. **Insurance also includes \$50,000 in medical benefits, \$1,000 for lost baggage, \$250 for baggage delay and \$50,000 for Common Carrier AD&D.**
