Day 1: Thursday, August 9

Overnight Flight

Half timber houses, vineyards, yodelers and some of the world's most picturesque villages await us. We'll explore Europe's most picturesque countries: **Austria, Germany (Bavaria) and Switzerland** following our overnight flight which arrives in Vienna, Austria before noon.

Day 2: Friday, August 10

Vienna, Austria - Tour Begins

Our tour begins in Vienna. Our flight arrives in the morning and we'll have some free time to adjust and rest. Tonight, we'll have a special welcome dinner, complete with local entertainers, in the quaint village of **Grinzing**, one of the charming towns in the foothills of the Alps just outside of the city – a perfect way to start our tour. *Today dinner will be included.*

Day 3: Saturday, August 11

Vienna

This morning, a local guide will show us the highlights of this elegant and historically significant city. We'll see St. Stephen's Cathedral, Vienna's most famous landmark followed by a tour inside of **Schonbrunn Palace**, the former residence of the Austrian imperial family where Mozart performed as a young boy. Much of Europe was ruled from here for centuries. We'll also see the famous **Heldenplatz** where Hitler announced the annexation of Austria. It is an interesting city as you'll see. You'll have some free time in the afternoon to rest or enjoy some browsing. This evening, you'll have the option to see a **Strauss concert** which is a wonderful Vienna experience. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 4: Sunday, August 12

Vienna - Salzburg

After a short drive through the lovely countryside, we arrive at the beautiful **Danube River** where we'll board our boat for a cruise passing **lush countryside, attractive vineyards, ruined castles and the stunning Melk Abbey** where we'll enjoy a visit inside. Wait until you see this place! As the cruise ends, we'll continue by coach into one of Europe's most beautiful cities: **Salzburg, the "City of Music"**. Dinner is included tonight at the centuries-old **St. Peter's Restaurant**. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 5: Monday, August 13

Salzburg

Salzburg is a pedestrian city. We'll enter through **Mirabell Gardens** as we make our way into the Old Town. The majestic **Hohensalzburg Castle** guards the town. We'll see **Mozart's birthplace**, several sites from the "**Sound of Music**" the quaint, narrow shopping streets and a feel that is distinctly old Europe. And the mountain scene surrounding the city is magnificent. We'll have some free time to enjoy it at our leisure in the afternoon. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 6: Tuesday, August 14

Salzburg - Munich, Germany - Oberammergau

Today we make our way into Bavaria, in southern Germany. On the way, we've included a visit to the **Eagle's Nest**, one of Hitler's mountain hideaways. We'll take a 15 minute ride up one of Europe's most spectacular mountain roads, arriving at the elevator that takes through the mountain to the top where the views are beyond description. You can see back to Salzburg and on a nice day, there isn't a more impressive view in Europe. We'll then continue to **Munich** where we'll see some highlights like the famous **Glockenspiel and Marienplatz**, a beautiful square surrounded by shops, restaurants and cafes. We then continue a short distance to the quaint village of **Oberammergau** where we'll spend two evenings. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 7: Wednesday, August 15

Oberammergau - Innsbruck, Austria - Oberammergau

Oberammergau is known for its painted houses and exquisite woodworking. Our day trip today takes us over the spectacular **Bavarian Alps** en route to enchanting **Innsbruck**, located in Tyrolean Austria. Walk through the charming pedestrian streets and see such landmarks as The Golden Roof on a locally guided tour. We'll find it easy to understand why this city, during the 14th century, was the center of European culture and politics as you wind through the narrow cobblestone streets. We then return to Oberammergau for dinner and some time to enjoy this quaint town. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 8: Thursday, August 16

Oberammergau - Black Forest

Today fairy tales come to life with a picture stop at Bavaria's most famous castle, King Ludwig's **Neuschwanstein**. The setting is unrivaled. Next, we continue to the heart of the stunning **Black Forest**, a region famous for its artisans who create authentic cuckoo clocks, Hummels and wood carvings. The unique pine trees are so dense, that it gives the illusion of being a "Black Forest". We stay at the charming **Hofgut Sternen**, in the forest. Marie Antoinette stayed here as a teen on her way from Austria to Paris to become the queen of France! It is historic, charming and beautiful! *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 9: Friday, August 17

Black Forest - Bern, Switzerland - Zermatt

Welcome to **Switzerland**! We will travel across the border and make a stop in the capital of **Bern** where we'll show you the highlights (Albert Einstein calculated the details of his theory of relativity here). Later, visit one of the most photographed castles in the world, the **Chateau de Chillon**, located on serene **Lake Geneva**. We'll have a tour inside (this is a very interesting place). We then drive two hours to the relaxing pedestrian village of **Zermatt in the Swiss Alps**. This is the end of the road as you come up against the 14,000+ feet peaks of the mighty Alps. And framing the town is the mighty **Matterhorn**, perhaps the most majestic of all the European mountains. Tonight you'll have time to take a stroll and breathe in the fresh Alpine air in this town where no cars are allowed. It is peaceful, picturesque and serene and we'll enjoy it from our four star hotel. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 10: Saturday, August 18

Zermatt

After an orientation tour of this mountain resort village, the remainder of our day is at leisure. There is much to do here and all is easily accessible. We want you to be able to do what is most interesting to you. Get an up-close look at the famed Matterhorn, enjoy lunch at a local café, or just relax and explore at your own pace. **Zermatt is truly one of those special places on earth.** *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 11: Sunday, August 19

Zermatt - Grimsel Pass - Lucerne

Views of glaciers, crystal clear rivers and snow-capped mountains will invigorate us as we travel through the spectacular scenery of the **Grimsel Pass** and through the green valleys on our way to the city of **Lucerne**, the "Swiss Paradise on the Lake." Lucerne, in the HEART of Switzerland. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 12: Monday, August 20

Lucerne

This morning, embark on a scenic walking tour of this picturesque town, including a stroll through the romantic old town which is very interesting (including the famous flower-clad covered bridge that you see on many Swiss postcards. Later you'll have the option to take a boat ride on the lake or take an excursion to the top of **Mt. Pilatus** for some spectacular views in all directions. Tonight, we'll enjoy a farewell dinner celebrating the end of an incredible tour. You will have seen some of the greatest scenery in the world. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 13: Tuesday, August 21

Lucerne – Tour Ends

Today we transfer to the airport (in Zurich) for our flights home, enjoying memories that will last a lifetime. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Registration Information:

To make a reservation, simply **fill out the attached reservation form and send it to us with a deposit of \$400 per person.** When we receive your deposit, we will mail you a receipt confirming that you are registered for the tour. A letter with instructions, hotel itinerary flight information (if applicable) and luggage tags will be sent 90 days prior to departure at which time the balance will be due. You do not need to pay the balance until after you receive that packet. We require final payments in the form of a check. If that is not possible, arrangements can be made to use a credit card. Webb Tours accepts Visa, Mastercard and Discover. A 2% surcharge will be added for credit card final payments. Also, if there is insufficient demand for a private Webb Tour, tour participants will join other Collette Tour participants (with the same exact itinerary and dates).

Cancellation Penalties

We understand that you may need to cancel your trip for whatever reason. If it is 95 days or more before departure, all money will be refunded. If it is within 95 days, the following schedule applies

95 – 46 days prior	\$200 per person + insurance + any applicable airline fees
45 – 22 days prior	25% of total cost + insurance + any applicable airline fees
21 – 8 days prior	50% of total cost + insurance + any applicable airline fees
7 – 1 days prior	75% of total cost + insurance + any applicable airline fees
Day of departure	100% of total cost + insurance + any applicable airline fees

For airlines, specifically, tickets are generally non refundable when purchased. However, most airlines will allow the value of the canceled tickets to be reused for future travel, though a penalty may be assessed to reuse the tickets. If you have to cancel, Webb Tours will work with other providers to obtain as much refund as possible for our travelers.

Cancellation Insurance:

To avoid cancellation penalties, cancellation insurance may be purchased. Insurance will reimburse you for the non-refundable cancellation penalties imposed if you must cancel your trip for a covered reason like illness, injury or death to you, a traveling companion or an immediate family member. Other reasons for cancellation include Common Carrier-caused delays due to inclement weather, jury duty, or a documented traffic accident en route to departure.

The per person price for insurance for this tour is \$199

The insurance covers the land portion of your tour. Airline credit will be returned to you for future use (less airline penalty). If you are interested in the insurance, it is best to purchase it when your deposit is made as all preexisting conditions are waived. However, insurance may be purchased any time up to the point you make your final payment. Insurance cannot be purchased after your final payment is made. Webb Tours is not the insurer and acts as agent for the insurance company. To activate your insurance, we need your premium and your birth date. **Travel insurance also includes \$2,500 for baggage loss, \$500 for baggage delay, up to \$50,000 for medical expenses and up to \$50,000 for medical evacuation.**

Currency Fluctuation:

Webb Tours reserves the right to adjust the rates if necessary in order to reflect currency fluctuations larger than 10% from those used in our tour price. This is not likely to happen, but we must protect against it. A shift of that magnitude would quickly erase our tour profits. Of course, if the fluctuation moves in the opposite direction, we will reduce your tour price.
