Daily Itinerary for May 8-12

May 8: Today we meet at the Salt Lake Airport for our flight via Denver direct to the **New Branson Airport (while seats last)**, arriving in the early afternoon (there is only one flight per day into Branson from the west). Our luxury motor coach (restroom equipped) will be waiting to transport us into town. Your director will share interesting and educational information along the way. After a welcome dinner tonight at Grand Country Buffet, we'll enjoy our first show: *The Dutton Family*. The Duttons have been in Branson for 10+ years now and they are VERY talented. No other place in the U.S. puts on a musical party like they do in Branson, Missouri, and nobody can show it to you like Webb Tours, now in our 23rd year taking folks to the Ozarks. We'll stay in the same hotel for four nights (The Holiday Inn Express in a great location). **D**

May 9: After breakfast this morning, we'll have some time to show you around the Ozarks. This area is not only famous for its entertainment, it also shows off some striking natural beauty, especially in May. After lunch, we'll enjoy the talented *Yakov Smirnoff*. Yakov is the famous Russian comedian who has been entertaining Branson audiences for nearly 20 years. You WILL laugh. All of our groups have LOVED him. Dinner is at Landry's Steak & Seafood House followed by the *Presley's Country Jubilee*, performed by Branson's first family. They opened their theater in 1962 and subsequent generations are still performing today. It is perhaps the best country music show in town, full of great music, hilarious comedy and fun country dancing. **B, D**

May 10: Breakfast at the hotel followed by a visit to *Silver Dollar City*. You may not have heard of it. You will be impressed. It is an Ozark Mountain Theme-Park where you step back in time. The park recreates an Ozarks town of the late 1800's with atmosphere that is second to none. There are great shows, wonderful food and unique shopping. It is also home to Marvel Cave and several attractions, all in a beautiful, natural setting. It also happens to coincide to the annual Blue Grass/Barbecue Festival which adds an additional element of fun. We'll spend several hours there (it is a must-see!). After resting at the hotel, we'll go out for a nice dinner at the Lone Star Steak House followed by a Branson's best known entertainer: *Shoji Tabuchi*. Whether it's your first or fifth time to see him, you always get your money's worth. With a 70 person cast, elaborate sets and Shoji's unique gifts, this show always delivers. **B, D**

May 11: You'll have a free morning today and we'll provide some options – perhaps an extra show, a round of golf, a little shopping, etc. We'll provide the options and the transportation, you choose what you want to do. After lunch, we'll enjoy a show that is quickly becoming the toughest ticket in town. They are known as *SIX*. This is a group of 6 brothers (the Knudsen Brothers) from Utah that have been “discovered” in Branson. Trip Advisor recently rated it the #1 show in Branson (out of 126 shows in town). After a rest at the hotel, we will then drive a short distance to Table Rock Lake to enjoy a delightful variety show (called Encore) and dinner on board the beautiful *Showboat Branson Belle*. This continues to be one of the best activities in Branson. The food, entertainment and scenery around Table Rock Lake are exceptional. **B, D**

May 12: After breakfast today, you'll have a chance to enjoy one final (and excellent) show performed by the *Brett Family*, universally loved in Branson. We will then drive 20 minutes back to the Branson Airport for our flights home, arriving around 7:30 PM. **B**

Tour price includes airfare to the new Branson airport, all transportation, lodging, 8 meals, 7 shows and is fully escorted by directors that have been to Branson many times. The only thing you will pay in addition to the tour price is lunch each day and souvenirs.

Registration Information:

To make a reservation, simply **fill out the attached reservation form and send it to us with a deposit of \$300 per person.** When we receive your deposit, we will mail you a receipt confirming that you are registered for the tour. A letter with instructions, hotel itinerary flight information (if applicable) and luggage tags will be sent 45-60 days prior to departure at which time the balance will be due. You do not need to pay the balance until after you receive that packet. We require final payments in the form of a check. If that is not possible, arrangements can be made to use a credit card. Webb Tours accepts Visa, Mastercard and Discover.

Cancellation Penalties

We understand that you may need to cancel your trip for whatever reason. If it is 60 days or more before departure, all money will be refunded. If airline tickets are purchased prior to that time (with your permission), they become the property of the traveler and are not refundable. All other funds will be returned if cancellation occurs outside of 60 days. If it is within 60 days, we will charge you only what Webb Tours cannot recover. In some cases, we can recover all of it. In others, we cannot. Cruise lines, airlines, hotels and other service providers require funds in advance and have their own rules about what will be refunded once paid. We must follow their guidelines. For airlines, specifically, tickets are generally non refundable when purchased. However, most airlines will allow the value of the canceled tickets to be reused for future travel, though a penalty may be assessed to reuse the tickets. If you have to cancel, Webb Tours will work with other providers to obtain as much refund as possible for our travelers. Our travelers know us to be very fair in this regard.

Cancellation Insurance:

Cancellation insurance is also available should you be interested. The insurance provider that we use is a company called Travelex. You can learn about them at www.travelexinsurance.com. With this insurance, most of your money will be returned to you in case you have to cancel for covered reasons (illness or death of an immediate family member) at the last minute. The price for the insurance varies based on the price of the trip and the age of the participant (at the time the insurance is purchased). Prices are as follows:

If you are interested in the insurance, it is best to purchase it when your deposit is made as all preexisting conditions are waived. However, insurance may be purchased any time up to the point you make your final payment. Insurance cannot be purchased after your final payment is made. Webb Tours is not the insurer and acts as agent for Travelex. To activate your insurance, we need your premium and your birth date. **Insurance also includes \$50,000 in medical benefits, \$1,000 for lost baggage, \$250 for baggage delay and \$50,000 for Common Carrier AD&D.**

Comfortable, well equipped bus: We use Cavallo Bus Lines out of the Midwest. Buses are new and are equipped with video, restroom, excellent sound systems and air conditioning. And the drivers enhance the tours with their personality and expertise. We don't have randomly assigned drivers. They are drivers that we have used in the past so we know they are excellent.

Excellent guides: The guides are one of the most important parts of the tour. Guides perform at least four functions: 1) They keep things moving according to the schedule, 2) They facilitate a fun, relaxed environment, 3) They inform about topics or places of special or historical significance and 4) provide solutions to any problems which may occur. Our guides are specially chosen and are well qualified in all areas. They are sensitive and caring, as well as knowledgeable and fun. They have been to Branson MANY times.
