A Scripture Study Tour of the Holy Land and Egypt

Days 1 and 2: Monday & Tuesday, March 12 & 13 Transatlantic Flight • Tel Aviv, Israel • Joppa

We're off! Our exciting adventure begins with a morning flight from Salt Lake City (or home airport) to Tel Aviv, Israel. Arriving in the afternoon, we catch our first glimpse of the Holy Land as we land at Ben Gurion Airport. Following arrival formalities, we will be met by our guide and luxury coach driver, who will take us to the old city of **Joppa** that, according to legend was settled by Japheth, Noah's youngest son, and is known as one of the world's oldest cities. We will travel on to **Tel Aviv**, where we will overnight at the lovely Metropolitan Hotel (or similar), just a block from the Mediterranean Sea. D

Day 3: Wednesday, March 14 Caesarea • Mount Carmel • Haifa • Megiddo

Continuing up the coast, we will visit the extensive ruins of ancient **Caesarea**, the magnificent seaport and capital city built by Herod the Great. Next we will visit **Mount Carmel**, the traditional site of Elijah's confrontation with the priests of Baal. On we go to **Haifa**, Israel's third largest city and major seaport, stopping at Kaiser's Watch, where two apostles dedicated the Holy Land. Our final stop will be **Megiddo** in the beautiful Jezreel Valley. We will check in to our hotel near the **Sea of Galilee** for two nights. We also visit Nof Ginosar where we will view an ancient boat from the time of Christ that has been reclaimed from the sea. B, D

Day 4: Thursday, March 15 Capernaum • Mount of Beatitudes • Mount Tabor • Nazareth

It is easy to see why Jesus loved Galilee as we visit places where He walked, taught, and performed many miracles. This morning we will boat across the Sea of Galilee to visit the ruins of **Capernaum**, the town Jesus called His own city, where He spent almost two years of His three-year ministry. At the **Mount of Beatitudes** we will take time to reflect on Jesus' great Sermon on the Mount. Next we will ascend **Mount Tabor**, the traditional site of the Transfiguration. We then journey to **Nazareth**, the bustling city which was once the little town where Jesus spent His youth. At Nazareth we visit a first-century village showing life at the time of Christ. We stay again in Tiberius tonight. B, D

Day 5: Friday, March 16 Dan • Jericho • Bethany • Jerusalem

This morning we view two sites at the headwaters of the Jordan River: **Dan**, ancient Israel's northern-most city, and **Banias**, called Caesarea Philippi in Jesus' time. Driving south we travel to **Jericho**, the ancient city conquered by Joshua. Ascending the east side of the Mount of Olives, we visit **Bethany**, home of Mary, Martha, and Lazarus, and where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead. We then take our first glimpse of Jerusalem and visit the "Western Wall" on the Jewish Sabbath. We will stay at the lovely **Olive Tree Hotel** in Jerusalem for the next six nights. B, D

Day 6: Saturday, March 17 Jerusalem • Bethlehem

We begin this Sabbath at the **Garden Tomb** and move on to a Jerusalem overlook on the **Mount of Olives** for group pictures. We will attend church services at the **BYU Jerusalem Center**. After lunch we travel south to **Bethlehem**. We will stop at **Shepherds' Field** to sing carols, read the Christmas story, and review the events of Jesus' birth; we'll then continue into the city to the **Church of the Nativity**. B, D

Day 7: Sunday, March 18 Jerusalem

We start the day with a meeting in our hotel before we go to the **Temple Mount**, Mount Moriah, where Abraham came to offer Isaac, where the temple of Solomon and the second Temple stood, and where Muslim tradition holds that Mohammed ascended into paradise. This is a holy site in the world to three great religions. We will see the **Dome of the Rock**, **El Aksa Mosque**, and the **Golden Gates**. We then walk to **Saint Annes Church** & the pool of Bethesda where Jesus healed a crippled man. We then walk through the Old City past the Stations of the Cross; to the **Antonia Fortress** where Jesus may have been tried by Pilate

and to the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**, the traditional site of the crucifixion, burial tomb, and resurrection. B, D

Day 8: Monday, March 19 Qumran • Masada • Dead Sea

This morning we travel through the Judean Wilderness to the Dead Sea to **Qumran**. At Qumran we see the remains of the village where the Essenes lived, who wrote and hid the Dead Sea Scrolls in caves. We travel on to the spectacular fortress of **Masada**, where we will ascend by gondola to see the ruins of the palace/fortress built by Herod. We will next stop at **Ein Gedi** for a swim in the Dead Sea. B, D

Day 9: Tuesday, March 20 Jerusalem • Yad Vashem • Model City • City of David

The day begins with a visit to **Yad Vashem** (the Holocaust Museum). After driving by the **Knesset**, we will go to the Israel Museum to see the **Shrine of the Book** (where the Dead Sea Scrolls are exhibited) and the **Model City of Jerusalem**, which shows how the city looked at the time of the Savior. We return to the Dung Gate to enter the **Ophel Archaeological Gardens**, where we know for certain that Jesus walked. Descending south we enter the **City of David**, where we visit Warren's Shaft and Gihon Spring; here we will enter **Hezekiah's Tunnel** dug by King Hezekiah's workmen at the time the Northern Kingdom was taken captive by Assyria and Jerusalem was threatened by siege in the eighth century BC. We exit the tunnel near the **Pool of Siloam**, where Jesus restored a blind man's sight. B, D

Day 10: Wednesday, March 21 Jerusalem • Last Week of Christ's Life

This may be the most spiritual and meaningful day of our tour as we recreate the week of atoning sacrifice, visiting the unforgettable places of the last week of Jesus' life. And it falls on April 6, which is a treat: See the **Upper Room**, where Jesus initiated the sacrament; the **Palace of Caiaphas** where Jesus was tried by the Sanhedrin; and the **Church of All Nations** and the **Garden of Gethsemane**, where Christ atoned for our sins. After visiting the **Orson Hyde Memorial Garden**, we'll continue on to **Golgotha** and the **Garden Tomb**, where we will take time to reflect on the resurrection of Jesus and its significance to us. B, D

Day 11: Thursday, March 22 Ben Gurion Airport • Cairo, Egypt

Today we bid farewell to Israel. Those flying back home will depart Tel Aviv for the States. Others will catch the flight to **Cairo**. A great tour to the famous **Pyramids of Giza**, the **Sphinx**, **Memphis** and **Saqqara**. A **camel ride** from the Giza Pyramids to the Sphinx is included. Lunch provided in Sakkara. Dinner at hotel and evening at the Sound and Light Show at the Pyramids. We stay at the Meridian Pyramids tonight. B, D

Day 12-15: Friday, March 23 – Monday, March 26: NILE CRUISE

For three days, we will enjoy a spectacular cruise on the world's longest river: The Nile. Our Movenpick Cruise is luxurious and all meals are included. We take a short flight to **Aswan**, where the cruise begins. We'll travel through **Edfu** and into **Luxor** with a chance to see significant highlights in each place. In Luxor, we'll see the **Luxor Temple**, **Karnak Temple**, **Colossi of Memnon**, **Funerary Temple of Hapsepshut**, **Valley of the Kings** (tombs of the Pharaohs), **Temple of Medinet Habu**. The cruise is a relaxing and excellent way to see these cities on the Nile. In Aswan, we'll marvel at one of the world's largest dams and enjoy the sunset in Egypt's southern-most city (gateway to the rest of Africa). Edfu is on the west bank of the Nile where we'll see the **Temple of Horus**, Egypt's best preserved temple. Our cruise ends back in Luxor where we catch a short flight back to Cairo. B, L, D on all days

Day 15-16: Tuesday & Wednesday, March 27-28: Cairo

There is much more to see in Cairo on our final day and a half. We'll see the world-famous **Cairo Museum**. We'll also have a chance to visit the **Old City of Cairo**, the **Citadel** and **Alabaster Mosque**, and pass through the **City of the Dead**. Dinner at the hotel both nights. B, D

Day 17, Thursday, March 29 FLIGHTS HOME, arriving back in home cities on the same day.

Registration Information:

To make a reservation, simply **fill out the attached reservation form and send it to us with a deposit of \$300 per person.** When we receive your deposit, we will mail you a receipt confirming that you are registered for the tour. A letter with instructions, hotel itinerary flight information (if applicable) and luggage tags will be sent 45-60 days prior to departure at which time the balance will be due. You do not need to pay the balance until after you receive that packet. We require final payments in the form of a check. If that is not possible, arrangements can be made to use a credit card. Webb Tours accepts Visa, Mastercard and Discover.

Cancellation Penalties

We understand that you may need to cancel your trip for whatever reason. If it is 75 days or more before departure, all money will be refunded. If it is within 75 days, we will charge you only what Webb Tours cannot recover. In some cases, we can recover all of it. In others, we cannot. Cruise lines, airlines, hotels and other service providers require funds in advance and have their own rules about what will be refunded once paid. We must follow their guidelines. For airlines, specifically, tickets are generally non refundable when purchased. However, most airlines will allow the value of the canceled tickets to be reused for future travel, though a penalty may be assessed to reuse the tickets. If you have to cancel, Webb Tours will work with other providers to obtain as much refund as possible for our travelers. Our travelers know us to be very fair in this regard.

Cancellation Insurance:

To avoid cancellation penalties, cancellation insurance may be purchased. This insurance will reimburse you for the non-refundable cancellation penalties imposed if you must cancel your trip for a covered reason such as illness, injury or death to you, a traveling companion or an immediate family member. Other reasons for cancellation include Common Carrier-caused delays due to inclement weather, jury duty, or a documented traffic accident en route to departure.

If you are interested in the insurance, it is best to purchase it when your deposit is made as all preexisting conditions are waived. However, insurance may be purchased any time up to the point you make your final payment. Insurance cannot be purchased after your final payment is made. Webb Tours is not the insurer and acts as agent for the insurance company. To activate your insurance, we need your premium and your birth date. **Travel insurance also includes \$2,500 for baggage loss, \$500 for baggage delay, up to \$50,000 for medical expenses and up to \$50,000 for medical evacuation.**

Currency Fluctuation:

Webb Tours reserves the right to adjust the rates if necessary in order to reflect currency fluctuations larger than 10% from those used in our tour price. This is not likely to happen, but we must protect against it. A shift of that magnitude would quickly erase our tour profits. Of course, if the fluctuation moves in the opposite direction, we will reduce your tour price.
