April 4, 2011: Early morning departure to Fort Lauderdale. Transfer to the ship and prepare to sail on the beautiful Coral Princess. The ship departs at 6:00 PM this evening. Note: If flights don't arrive in time, it will be necessary to depart on April 3rd.

April 5 and 6: At sea enjoying the turquoise waters of the Caribbean. This is your chance to explore your floating resort and become familiar with the amenities on board. There are plenty of activities to choose from – or just relax and read a book. Enjoy the hospitality for which Princess is famous. Dinner with Princess happens when you want it to and can be different every day. And there are many dining rooms to choose from.

April 7: Port of Call in Dutch-owned Aruba. Optional Webb Tours private excursions will include a visit to Aruba's Butterfly Farm with a guide who provides interesting information. We then see the landscape of the island (with the famous divi-divi trees) as we make our way to the Aloe Factory to learn how Aloe is grown and processed. Then we see the interesting Ayo rock formation and the natural gardens that lie among the rocks. You'll have a chance for some shopping in Oranjestad before returning to the ship. It's an interesting day

April 8: Port of call in Cartagena, Columbia. Your Webb Tours optional private excursion will show you this interesting port city and include a visit to the famous Bocachica Fortress. Cartagena was a famous port for pirates in the 16th and 17th centuries (as gold was being transported to Spain). It is an interesting place to visit.

April 9: By 5:00 AM this morning we begin to approach the locks of the Panama Canal. Later in the morning, we'll enter the canal through the Gatun Locks. The Coral Princess is built specifically for the Panama Canal and there are barely inches to spare on either side as we go through the locks. We'll then enjoy some scenic cruising in Gatun Lake as our narrator continues to enlighten us about the canal. We will stop for three hours this afternoon in Colon, Panama. No excursions are included, but this is a fun chance to do a little browsing in Panama. We then return through the Gatun Locks and back into the Caribbean Sea. It is a fascinating day that you'll long remember.

April 10: Port of call in lovely Costa Rica. Optional Webb Tours excursion will include a scenic coach ride to the Tortugero Canals. We'll board or covered eco-jungle boat for a leisurely two hour ride through these jungle canals that parallel the ocean. Our guides will provide interesting information while we look for monkeys, sloths, toucans and crocodiles.

April 11: At sea today. A chance to continue to enjoy the lovely Coral Princess. There are multiple pools and hot tubs, spas, multiple lounges, attractive public areas and much more.

April 12: Port of call in lovely Ocho Rios, Jamaica. Optional Webb Tours excursion will include a visit to famous Dunns River Falls (see front of brochure) along with other Ocho Rios highlights.

April 14: Arrive Fort Lauderdale and transfer to airport for flights home.

These prices include cruise, taxes, port charges and government fees and all meals on the ship. Transfers and Miami activities are additional.

Registration Information:

To make a reservation, simply **fill out the attached reservation form and send it to us with a deposit of \$400 per person.** When we receive your deposit, we will mail you a receipt confirming that you are registered for the tour. A letter with instructions, hotel address, flight information and more will be sent 90 days prior to departure at which time the balance will be due. You do not need to pay the balance until after you receive that packet. We require final payments in the form of a check. If that is not possible, arrangements can be made to use a credit card. Webb Tours accepts Visa, Mastercard and Discover for tour deposits.

Cancellation Penalties

We understand that you may need to cancel your trip for whatever reason. If it is 76 days or more before departure, all money will be refunded. If it is within 75 days, we will charge you only what the cruise line charges us. If cancellation occurs between 75 days and 31 days prior to departure, you will forfeit your deposit. If it is within 30 days of departure, additional penalties (up to the total amount) will apply. For airlines, specifically, tickets are generally non refundable when purchased. However, most airlines will allow the value of the canceled tickets to be reused for future travel, though a penalty may be assessed to reuse the tickets. If you have to cancel, Webb Tours will work with other providers to obtain as much refund as possible for our travelers. Our travelers know us to be very fair in this regard.

Cancellation Insurance:

Cancellation insurance is also available should you be interested. The insurance provider that we use is a company called Travelex. You can learn about them at www.travelexinsurance.com. With this insurance, most of your money will be returned to you in case you have to cancel for covered reasons (illness or death of an immediate family member) at the last minute. The price for the insurance varies based on the price of the trip and the age of the participant (at the time the insurance is purchased). Prices are as follows:

Webb Tours is not the insurer and acts as agent for Travelex. To activate your insurance, we need your premium and your birth date. **Insurance also includes trip interruption coverage (if you have to leave the tour early), \$500,000 medical evacuation, \$50,000 in medical benefits, \$1,000 for lost baggage and \$250 for baggage delay.**
