Day 1: Thursday, June 13

Overnight Flight

Spain and Portugal offer world-changing history, beautiful landscapes, towering mountains, lush countryside and pristine coastline. From Roman Aqueducts to Moorish Castles to stunning Cathedrals. We'll depart S the USA today and arrive in Lisbon, Portugal tomorrow morning.

Day 2: Thursday, June 14

Lisbon, Portugal

Welcome to Portugal, where quaint farming villages and cork and olive tree plantations dot the landscape. Enjoy Lisbon, Portugal's vibrant capital city. Tonight, we enjoy a welcome dinner together as we all get better acquainted. *Today dinner will be included.*

Day 3: Friday, June 15

Lisbon

A tour of Lisbon features the Moorish Alfama Quarter with its narrow streets and whitewashed structures followed by a visit to Jeronimo's Monastery (UNESCO World Heritage site), Monument to the Discoveries, and the Tower of Belem (UNESCO World Heritage site). Optional tour this afternoon to visit the charming town of Sintra. Tonight is a treat as we enjoy a dinner complete with local cuisine, folkloric dances and Portugal's famous Fado music. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 4: Saturday, June 16

Lisbon - Fatima - Nazare - Obidos - Lisbon

Our full day tour begins with a drive through the countryside to the town of Fatima. We'll visit the Batalha Monastery (UNESCO World Heritage site), a place of pilgrimage for millions. We'll then visit the ocean-front town of Nazare followed by some time to enjoy charming Obido with its imposing castle, Roman ruins and just plain charm. We then return to Lisbon. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 5: Sunday, June 17

Lisbon - Madrid, Spain

Depart Lisbon as we make our way to Spain. We'll travel through the town of Evora with some of Europe's best preserved Roman ruins. We'll enjoy the countryside Spain as we learn important history and prepare for the treasures of this unique country. We will arrive in Madrid in the early evening. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 6: Monday, June 18

Madrid - Toledo - Madrid

During a locally guided tour of Madrid's historic center, see the Puerta del Sol and Plaza Mayor, where events have been held since the 17th century. A guided tour of the monumental 18th century Royal Palace reveals lavish halls, banquet rooms, the throne room, royal armory and the impressive courtyard. **This afternoon, travel to Toledo, a UNESCO site and the capital of medieval Spain from the 700's to 1560. A comprehensive tour highlights the magnificent Gothic cathedral and the 13th century synagogue, a testament to Toledo's Jewish heritage.** Also stop in the Church of Santo Tome to view El Greco's masterpiece painting, The Burial of Count Orgaz. Toledo is one of EUROPE'S greatest treasures – and you'll see why. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 7: Tuesday, June 19

Madrid - Cordoba - Seville

Today we journey to the extraordinary Moorish city of Cordoba. We'll enjoy a walking tour of the Mezquita. This UNESCO site, an architectural marvel, built by the Moors in the 8th century as a magnificent mosque, was converted into the city's cathedral in the 16th century. We'll then have time to explore the old Jewish Quarter. The white houses, red roofs, hanging flower baskets and narrow streets create a wonderful ambiance. Our afternoon drive takes us to Seville, considered Spain's "cultural capital." *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 8: Wednesday, June 20

Seville

Today you will see Columbus' tomb, the ornate cathedral (a UNESCO site) and Giralda Bell Tower. Enjoy a walking tour of the quaint old Santa Cruz Quarter with its bright flowers, and winding streets. Continue to Plaza D'España and the beautiful Maria Luisa Park, one of the loveliest in all of Europe. **A local flamenco dancer joins you for a typical "tapas lunch" featuring small portions of hot and cold specialties; here you learn about the history, culture and artistry of flamenco.** This evening, take your reserved seats for an authentic flamenco show featuring Seville's top performers. It is an important part of the Spain experience. *Today breakfast and lunch will be included.*

Day 9: Thursday, June 21

Seville - Granada

Travel along the peaceful Sierra Nevada to Granada, the last great capital of the Moors in Spain before it fell to the Catholic monarchs in 1492. **Join a local expert for a tour of the world-famous Alhambra, the immense hilltop palace that is a UNESCO site.** Also tour the Generalife, meaning "garden of the architect," where the grounds are beautifully designed with waterfalls, courtyards and smaller secret gardens. It is one of the most amazing structures in all the world and an absolute MUST SEE! *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 10: Friday, June 22

Granada - Valencia

Today we travel through Spain's amazing landscape viewing rolling hills dotted with picturesque olive groves as we make our way to the Mediterranean coast. Arrive in the city of Valencia, a treasure trove of Roman and Arabic architecture, surrounded by citrus lovely groves. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 11: Saturday, June 23

Valencia - Lladro - Valencia

We'll start with a tour of historic Valencia featuring the ornate 14th century Serranos Tower and imposing 15th century Quart Tower. You'll also see the bustling central market, one of the largest in Europe, and view the Gothic Cathedral, where construction began in 1262 on the site of an ancient mosque. Our trip to Valencia would not be complete without a stop at Lonja, the old Silk Exchange, recognized by UNESCO as one of the most beautiful buildings of European civil Gothic architecture. **Later, visit Lladro-City of Porcelain and learn about the history and creative process of the world-famous, hand-made Lladro figurines.** The remainder of the day is at leisure for you to explore Valencia's amazing buildings and museums independently and stroll the walkways of this impressive city. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 12: Sunday, June 24

Valencia - Museum of Las Fallas - Barcelona

Begin your day with a visit to the Museum of Las Fallas where you will see figurines from the last 80 years of Las Fallas. Learn about this unique, spectacular festival from assembly and costumes to fireworks and the night of burning. Trust us. This is very interesting. Our interesting journey this afternoon takes us to Barcelona, one of Europe's most beautiful and exciting cities. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 13: Monday, June 25

Barcelona

Today, get an in-depth look at vibrant and lively Barcelona. Your locally guided tour showcases Las Ramblas Boulevard, the most famous in Barcelona, dotted with bird and flower stalls. Also see Columbus Monument; Parc Montjuic; Antonio Gaudi's UNESCO World Heritage sites including "La Sagrada Familia," Parc Guell, Bartlo House and the unconventional Casa Mila building. This afternoon continue to explore colorful Barcelona on your own. Gather this evening for a farewell dinner celebrating the end of a lovely trip to Spain! *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 14: Tuesday, June 26

Barcelona - Tour Ends

You return home with vivid memories of a spectacularly beautiful land with an old, rich and diverse cultural heritage. *Today breakfast will be included*

Registration Information:

To make a reservation, simply **fill out the attached reservation form and send it to us with a deposit of \$400 per person.** When we receive your deposit, we will mail you a receipt confirming that you are registered for the tour. A letter with instructions, hotel itinerary flight information (if applicable) and luggage tags will be sent 90 days prior to departure at which time the balance will be due. You do not need to pay the balance until after you receive that packet. We require final payments in the form of a check. If that is not possible, arrangements can be made to use a credit card. Webb Tours accepts Visa, Mastercard and Discover. A 2% surcharge will be added for credit card final payments. Also, if there is insufficient demand for a private Webb Tour, tour participants will join other Collette Tour participants (with the same exact itinerary and dates).

Cancellation Penalties

We understand that you may need to cancel your trip for whatever reason. If it is 95 days or more before departure, all money will be refunded. If it is within 95 days, the following schedule applies

95 – 46 days prior	\$200 per person + insurance + any applicable airline fees
45 – 22 days prior	25% of total cost + insurance + any applicable airline fees
21 – 8 days prior	50% of total cost + insurance + any applicable airline fees
7 – 1 days prior	75% of total cost + insurance + any applicable airline fees
Day of departure	100% of total cost + insurance + any applicable airline fees

For airlines, specifically, tickets are generally non refundable when purchased. However, most airlines will allow the value of the canceled tickets to be reused for future travel, though a penalty may be assessed to reuse the tickets. If you have to cancel, Webb Tours will work with other providers to obtain as much refund as possible for our travelers.

Cancellation Insurance:

To avoid cancellation penalties, cancellation insurance may be purchased. Insurance will reimburse you for the non-refundable cancellation penalties imposed if you must cancel your trip for a covered reason like illness, injury or death to you, a traveling companion or an immediate family member. Other reasons for cancellation include Common Carrier-caused delays due to inclement weather, jury duty, or a documented traffic accident en route to departure.

The per person price for insurance for this tour is \$199

The insurance covers the land portion of your tour. Airline credit will be returned to you for future use (less airline penalty). If you are interested in the insurance, it is best to purchase it when your deposit is made as all preexisting conditions are waived. However, insurance may be purchased any time up to the point you make your final payment. Insurance cannot be purchased after your final payment is made. Webb Tours is not the insurer and acts as agent for the insurance company. To activate your insurance, we need your premium and your birth date. **Travel insurance also includes \$2,500 for baggage loss, \$500 for baggage delay, up to \$50,000 for medical expenses and up to \$50,000 for medical evacuation.**

Currency Fluctuation:

Webb Tours reserves the right to adjust the rates if necessary in order to reflect currency fluctuations larger than 10% from those used in our tour price. This is not likely to happen, but we must protect against it. A shift of that magnitude would quickly erase our tour profits. Of course, if the fluctuation moves in the opposite direction, we will reduce your tour price.
