Tennessee offers a similar experience at the foot of the beautiful **Smoky Mountains**, but offers several things that you can't see in Branson. Add Nashville with its history, beauty and entertainment and you have the perfect Christmas vacation.*

*So take a look at the itinerary. We think you'll like what you see. But don't wait too long – there is huge advance interest in this tour and space is limited to one motor coach. We hope you can join us.*

### **Daily Itinerary:**

**Tuesday, November 30:** Today we board our flight to Nashville, Tennessee arriving in the early afternoon. Our deluxe, comfortable motor coach will be waiting to transport us to beautiful **Pigeon Forge**, at the foot of the Great Smoky Mountains. We'll stop for dinner about half way there, arriving at our hotel about 8:00 in the evening. We stay at the lovely Fairfield Inn & Suites. D

**Wednesday, December 1:** Welcome to Tennessee! After breakfast today, a local guide will show us around this interesting and beautiful area. We'll stop at the Visitor's Center before going into Smoky Mountain National Park. We'll enjoy several photo stops. We'll go up to Newfound Gap (just 45 minutes away) on the border of North Carolina and Tennessee (part of the Appalachian Trail), with sweeping views in all directions. Lunch will be on your own in interesting **Gatlinburg**. We then have an afternoon show called **Country Tonite**, one of the best country music shows in town. Dinner tonight is at the **Old Mill Restaurant** followed by an excellent show: **The Smith Family**. This is a great variety show featuring music, comedy and more. B, D

**Thursday, December 2:** After breakfast at the hotel, we'll enjoy a morning music show performed by the **Blackwood Brothers**. You probably haven't heard of them, but they put on a great show featuring gospel and Christmas music (they have sold over 50 million records). For lunch, we'll visit the interesting **Old Mill Village**. You'll have some free time this afternoon to choose from optional activities like another show, some shopping or a rest. We have a fun evening in store at Dolly Parton's **Dixie Stampede Dinner Theater**. You may have seen similar shows in Las Vegas or Branson. It is a delicious four course meal accompanied by a fabulous Christmas show featuring music, 32 beautiful horses, some crazy elves (you'll see), and a whole bunch of fun. On our way back to the hotel, we'll drive through the magical "**Winter Lights**" which will cap an enjoyable day. .B, D

**Friday, December 3:** Today after breakfast and a relaxing morning, we'll head back to Nashville (but first we'll show you a few things in Knoxville on the way). We'll arrive in beautiful **Nashville** in the early afternoon. You have a choice for lodging. You can stay at the fabulous Gaylord Opryland Hotel or the Hyatt Place at Opryland (a couple of blocks away), which is also a nice hotel. After a rest, we'll enjoy dinner and a delightful Christmas show aboard the **General Jackson Showboat** as it sails on the **Cumberland River**. This is like the Showboat in Branson that many of you have enjoyed with a delicious meal and a fun Christmas variety show (brand new in 2009). B, D

**Saturday, December 4:** Today we'll be joined by a professional local guide who will show us the highlights of this very interesting city including historic 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, Fort Nashorough, Music Row, Centennial Park, the Parthenon and more. Admission is included into the **Ryman Auditorium**. We'll then travel 20 minutes outside the city to see what is called **The Hermitage**. This was the home of Andrew Jackson, our colorful 7<sup>th</sup> US president (1829 to 1837). His estate is beautiful and the history is fascinating. Lunch is on your own at Opry Mills followed by an hour at one of the most interesting exhibits you'll ever see. It's called **ICE**. This walk-through exhibit features a life-sized nativity carved out of ice and several other rooms full of scenes made of clear and multi colored ice! You won't believe what you are seeing. After a rest at the hotel, we'll enjoy dinner at a local restaurant followed by the grand finale: **The Radio City Christmas Spectacular** featuring the world famous **Rockettes**. It is simply one of the best Christmas show that you will see anywhere....ever! B, D

**Sunday, December 5:** Today after breakfast, we'll enjoy some final activities before returning to the airport for our return flight to Salt Lake. B

**Registration Information:**

To make a reservation, simply **fill out the attached reservation form and send it to us with a deposit of \$300 per person.** When we receive your deposit, we will mail you a receipt confirming that you are registered for the tour. A letter with instructions, hotel itinerary flight information (if applicable) and luggage tags will be sent 45-60 days prior to departure at which time the balance will be due. You do not need to pay the balance until after you receive that packet. We require final payments in the form of a check. If that is not possible, arrangements can be made to use a credit card. Webb Tours accepts Visa, Mastercard and Discover.

**Cancellation Penalties**

We understand that you may need to cancel your trip for whatever reason. If it is 60 days or more before departure, all money will be refunded. If it is within 60 days, we will charge you only what Webb Tours cannot recover. In some cases, we can recover all of it. In others, we cannot. Cruise lines, airlines, hotels and other service providers require funds in advance and have their own rules about what will be refunded once paid. We must follow their guidelines. For airlines, specifically, tickets are generally non refundable when purchased. However, most airlines will allow the value of the canceled tickets to be reused for future travel, though a penalty may be assessed to reuse the tickets. If you have to cancel, Webb Tours will work with other providers to obtain as much refund as possible for our travelers. Our travelers know us to be very fair in this regard.

**Cancellation Insurance:**

Cancellation insurance is also available should you be interested. The insurance provider that we use is a company called Travelex. You can learn about them at [www.travelexinsurance.com](http://www.travelexinsurance.com). With this insurance, most of your money will be returned to you in case you have to cancel for covered reasons (illness or death of an immediate family member) at the last minute. The price for the insurance varies based on the price of the trip and the age of the participant (at the time the insurance is purchased). Prices are as follows:

To activate your insurance, we need your premium and your birth date. **Insurance also includes \$50,000 in medical benefits, \$1,000 for lost baggage, \$250 for baggage delay and \$50,000 for Common Carrier AD&D.**
